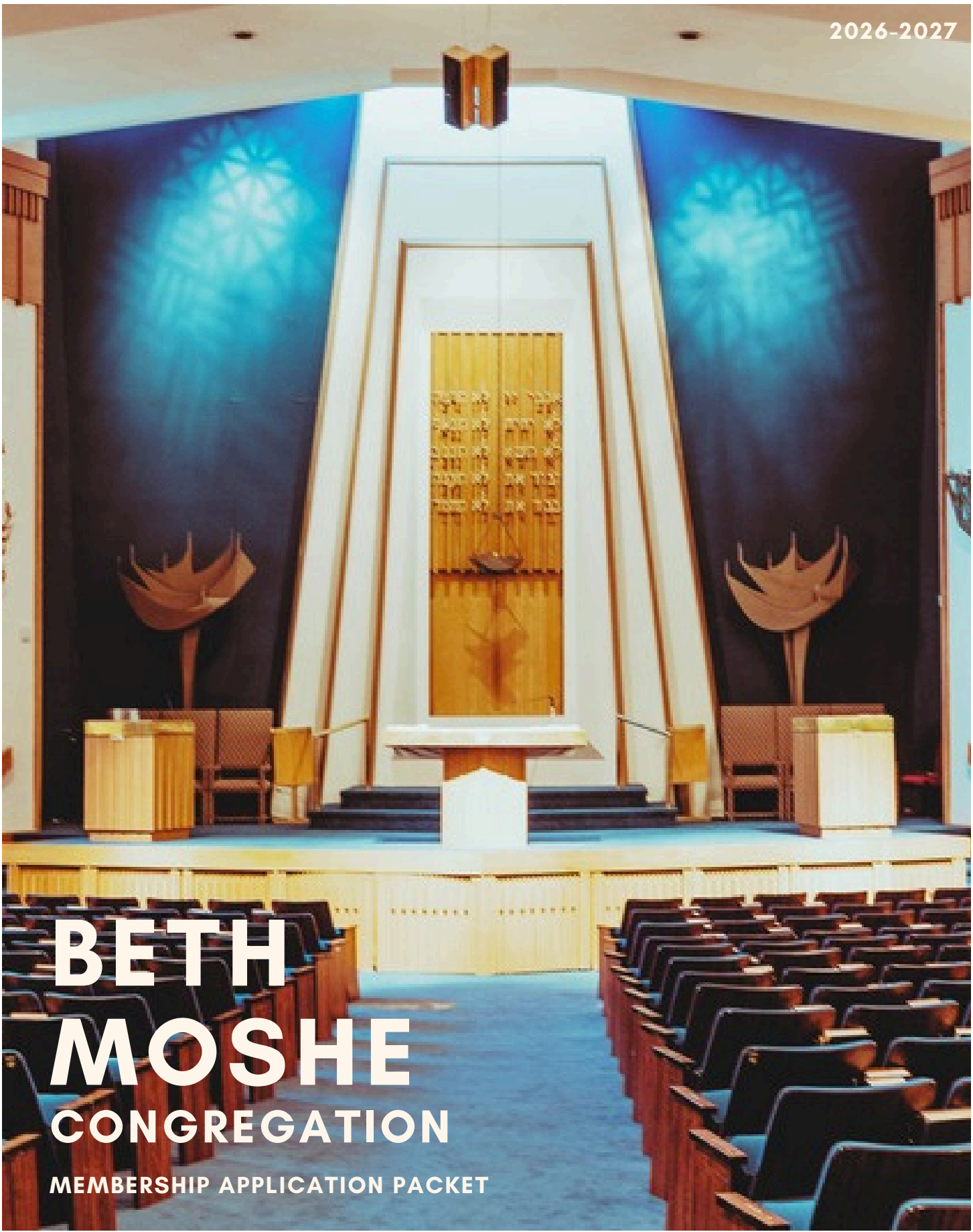
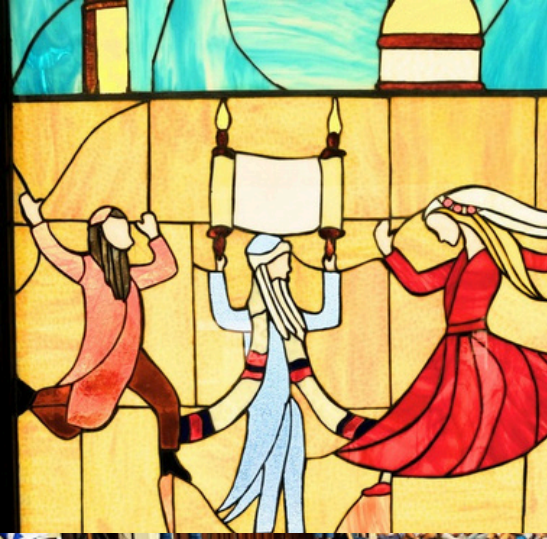

RELIGIOUS SERVICES

Saturday Morning Shabbat Services follow a traditional format, including Torah reading, meaningful prayer, and opportunities for learning. These services provide a grounding and spiritual start to the week, honoring the richness of Jewish tradition.

Jewish Holidays at Beth Moshe are marked with special celebrations for each festival throughout the year. From festive meals and rituals to educational programs and family activities, we embrace the unique spirit and traditions of every holiday on the Jewish calendar.

OUR CAMPUS

The Beth Moshe Sanctuary serves as the spiritual heart of our community. It is home to our Friday Night and Saturday Morning Shabbat services, community holiday celebrations, and private simchas. The Sanctuary offers a beautiful, reverent setting and comfortably seats up to 400 participants.

The Beth Moshe Social Hall is a versatile and elegant venue ideal for weddings, B'nai Mitzvah celebrations, brides, baby namings, birthday parties, fundraisers, lectures, and conferences. With a seating capacity of 250 guests, the Social Hall provides a warm and welcoming space for events both large and small.

The Beth Moshe Chapel offers an intimate setting for smaller religious services and celebrations. Accommodating up to 40 guests, the chapel is well-suited for weekday bar mitzvahs, baby namings, vow renewals, and other meaningful life-cycle moments.

The Jill & Stephen Bloch Cocktail Lobby is a bright and flexible gathering space well-suited for a variety of events and celebrations. The lobby accommodates up to 65 standing guests or 50 seated guests and is frequently used for Kiddush luncheons, brides, baby namings, and memorial services.

In Addition our campus also includes a dedicated preschool building, a youth house for programs and activities, two playgrounds, and a swimming pool—enhancing the vibrant educational, social, and recreational life of the Beth Moshe community.

OUR YOUTH PROGRAMS

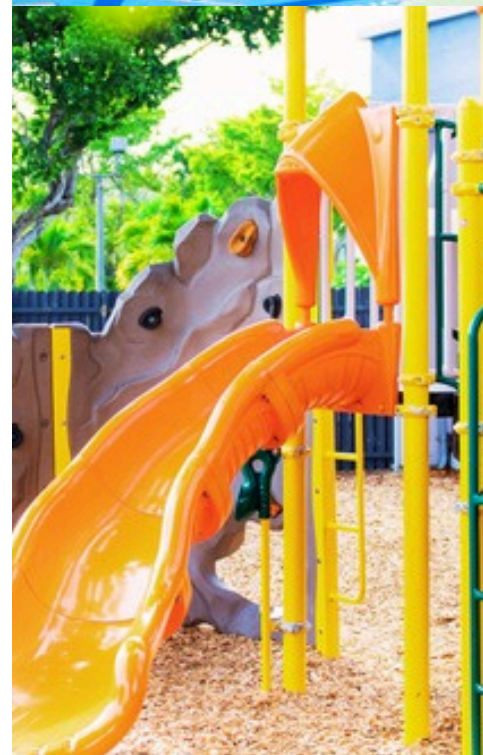
The Beth Moshe Preschool is an exciting, creative, and nurturing space for young children. We offer a developmentally appropriate curriculum for children ages 12 months through kindergarten, designed to foster curiosity, confidence, and a lifelong love of learning. Our Early Childhood Center provides outstanding educational programming and proudly opens its doors to families of all backgrounds, religions, abilities, and orientations, including interfaith families seeking a welcoming Jewish home.

Beth Moshe Summer Camp is a fun, safe, and intimate environment for campers to enjoy an unforgettable summer. With themed weeks, hands-on activities, and nurturing staff, children experience a joyful blend of play, creativity, and friendship—all on a campus that prioritizes safety and community.

Our Counselor-In-Training (CIT) Program offers teenagers in the community a meaningful opportunity to grow as leaders. Participants gain hands-on experience working with young campers, complete required volunteer hours for middle and high school, and develop skills in responsibility, communication, and teamwork.

The Beth Moshe Hebrew School offers Hebrew and Judaic instruction for children from kindergarten through seventh grade. Students rotate between Hebrew Language, Jewish Life, and Song & Prayer classes, ensuring a well-rounded and engaging Jewish education that prepares them for their B'nai Mitzvah and beyond.

Our B'nai Mitzvah Preparation Program guides young people as they take on new responsibilities in Jewish life. Students learn their Torah and Haftarah portions, master the prayers, and explore the meaning and responsibilities of becoming a Jewish adult. As part of this journey, we guide each student through designing and completing a meaningful mitzvah project—an opportunity to connect Jewish values with community action and personal passion.
